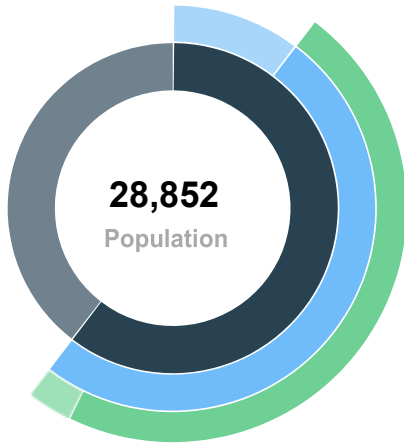

## Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population declined by 2.0% since 2015, falling by 599. Population is expected to decrease by 1.6% between 2020 and 2025, losing 472.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 4.7% in Garrett County, MD from 13,111 to 12,498. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.0% by 4.7%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 84.9% to 83.0% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, 11.9% of Garrett County, MD residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (8.1% below the national average), and 9.6% hold an Associate's Degree (1.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

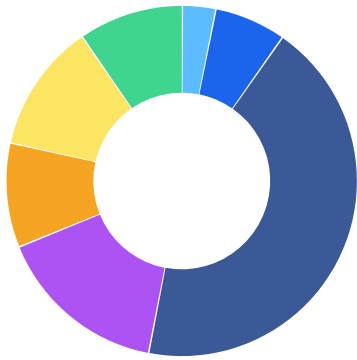

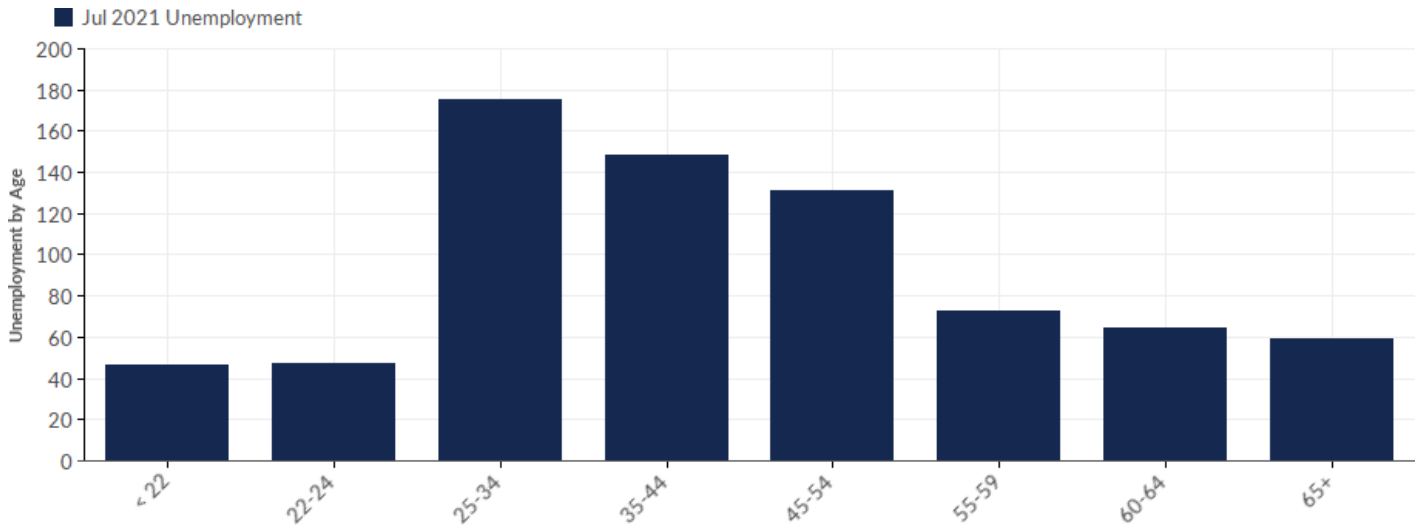

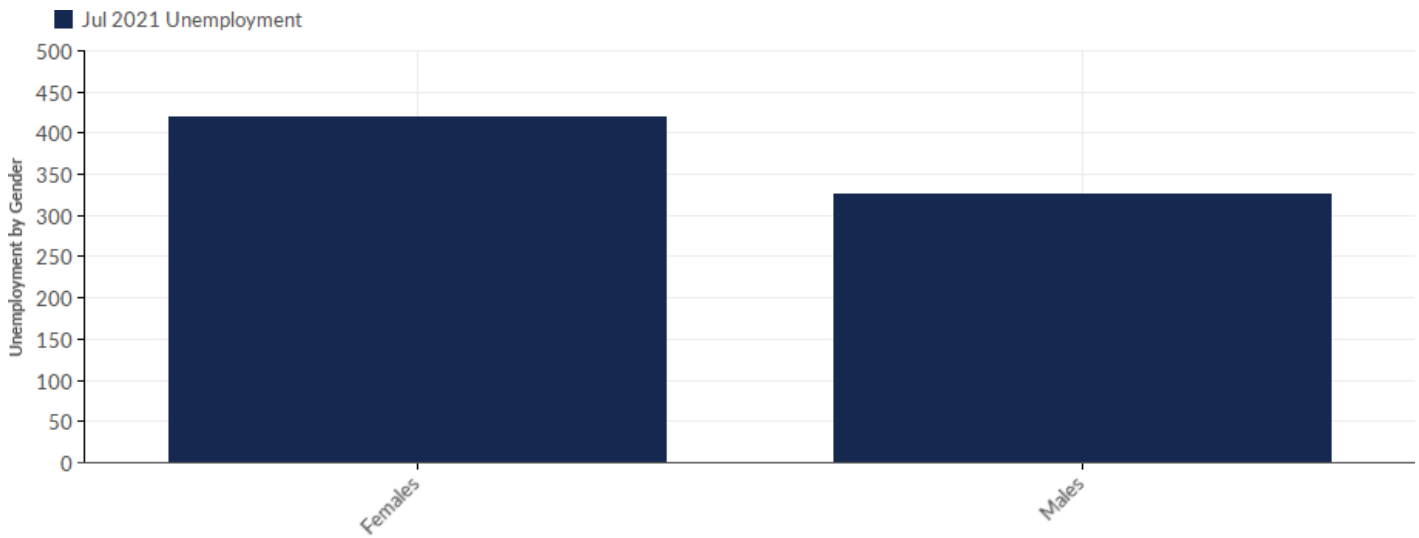

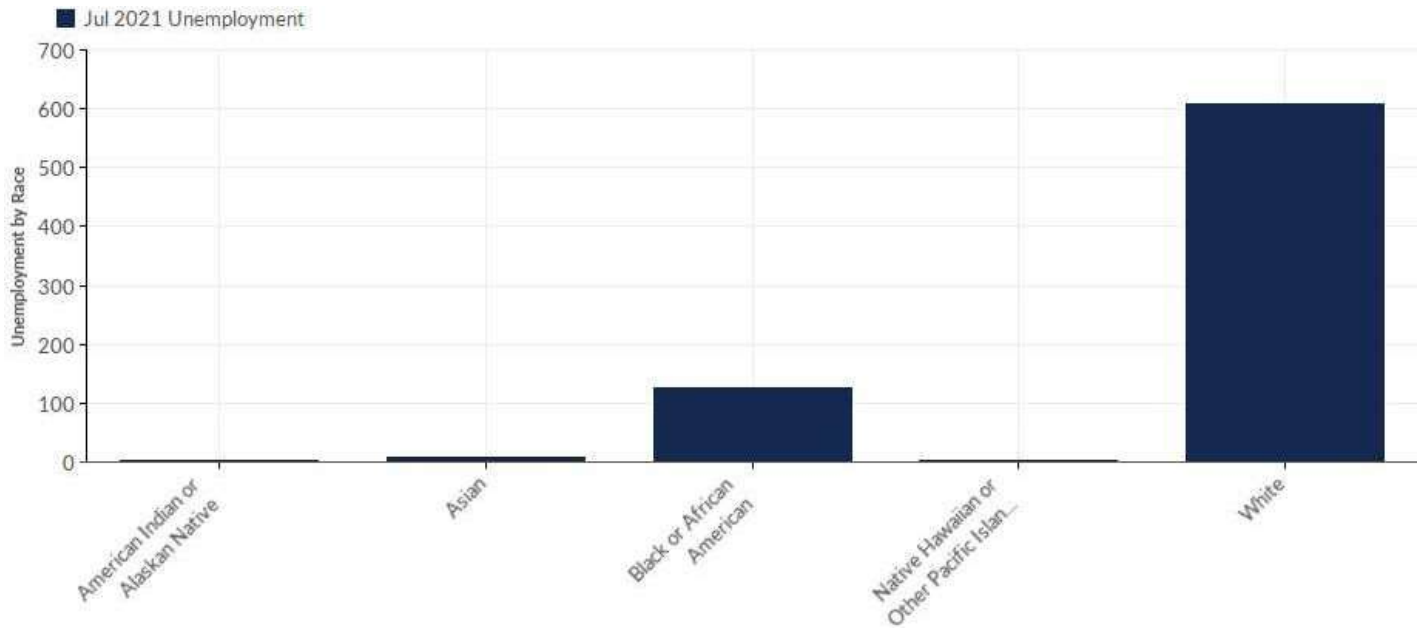


## Unemployment by Gender



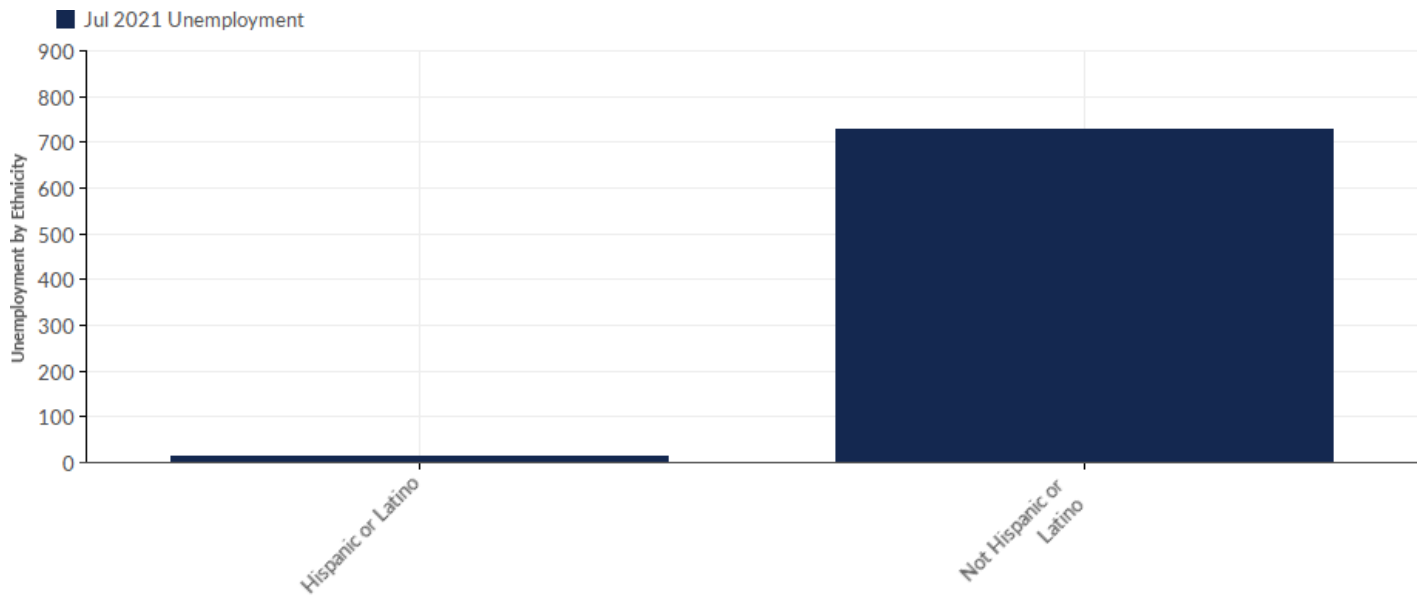

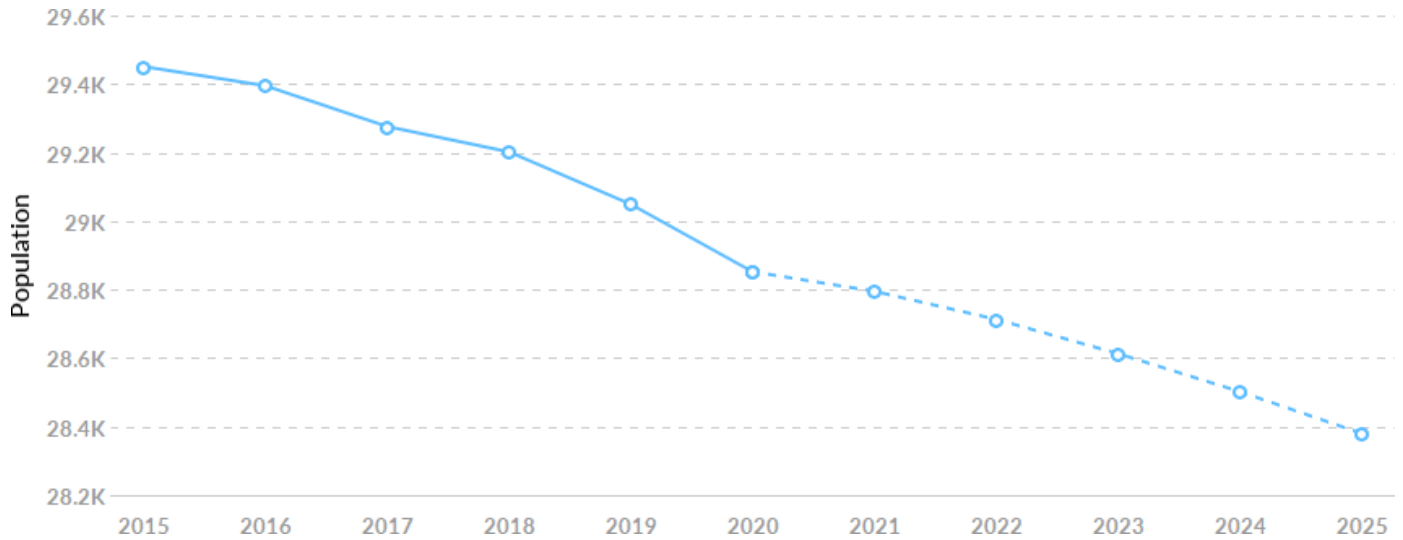

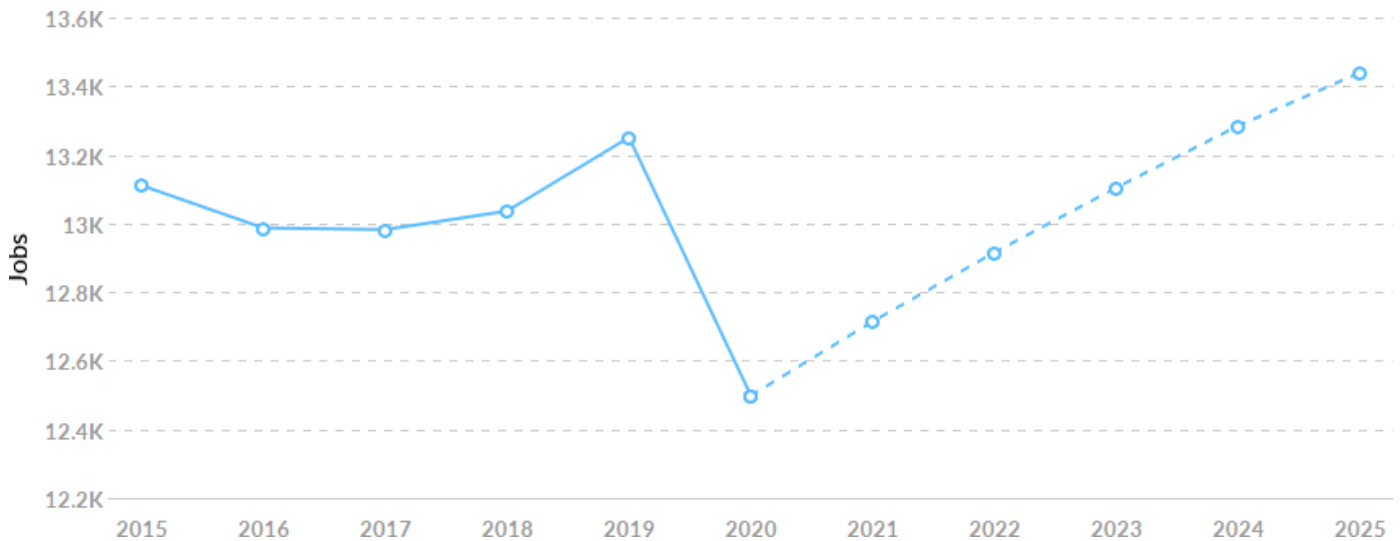

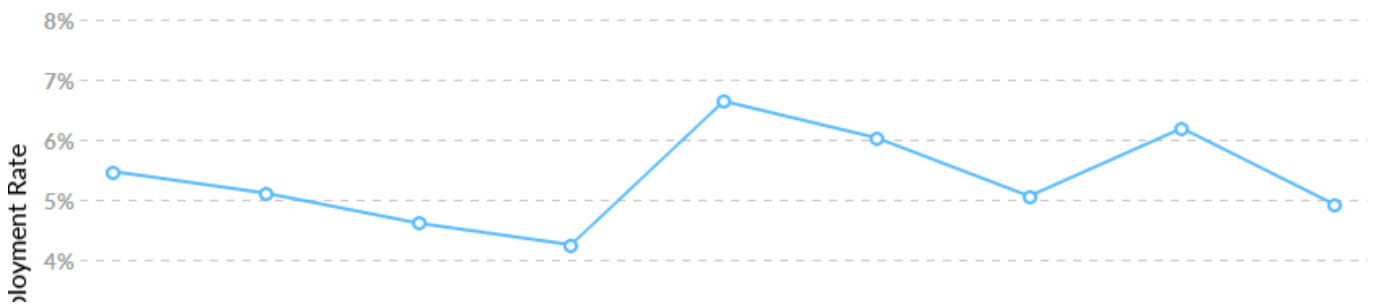

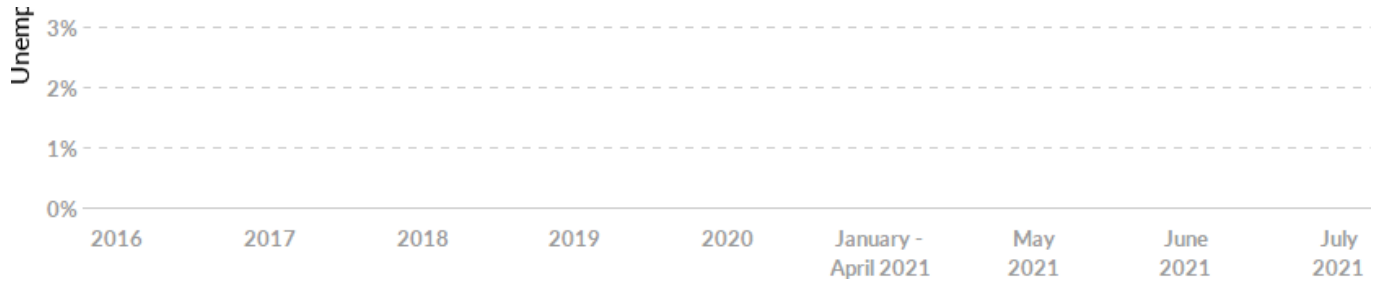

Garrett County, MD had a July 2021 unemployment rate of 4.92%, decreasing from 5.47% 5 years before.

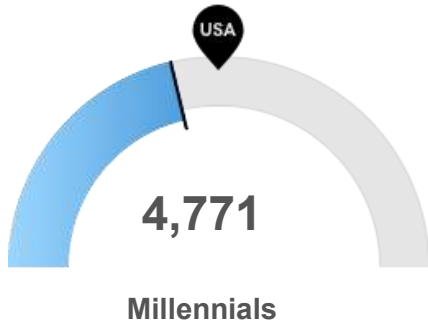




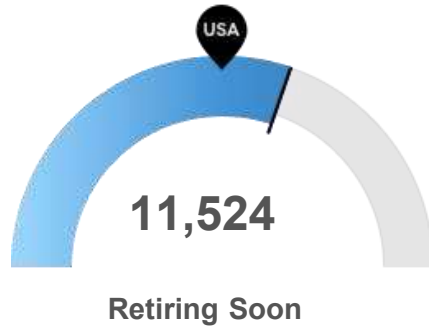

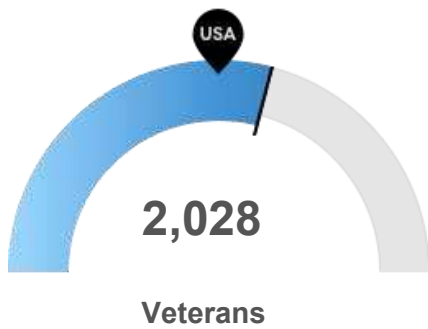
Garrett County, MD has 4,771 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,946.



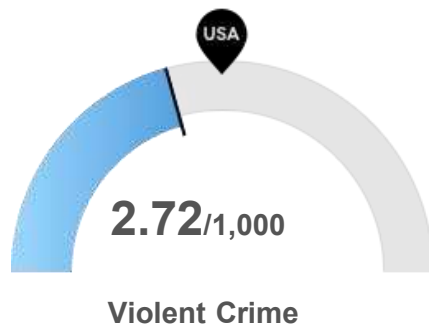
Retirement risk is high in Garrett County, MD. The national average for an area this size is 8,587 people 55 or older, while there are 11,524 here.



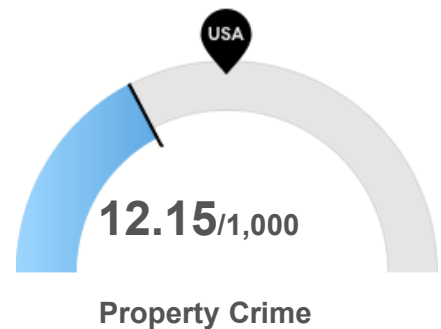
Racial diversity is low in Garrett County, MD. The national average for an areathis size is 11,621 racially diverse people, while there are 1,098 here.

Garrett County, MD has 12.15 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 19.78 per 1,000 people.

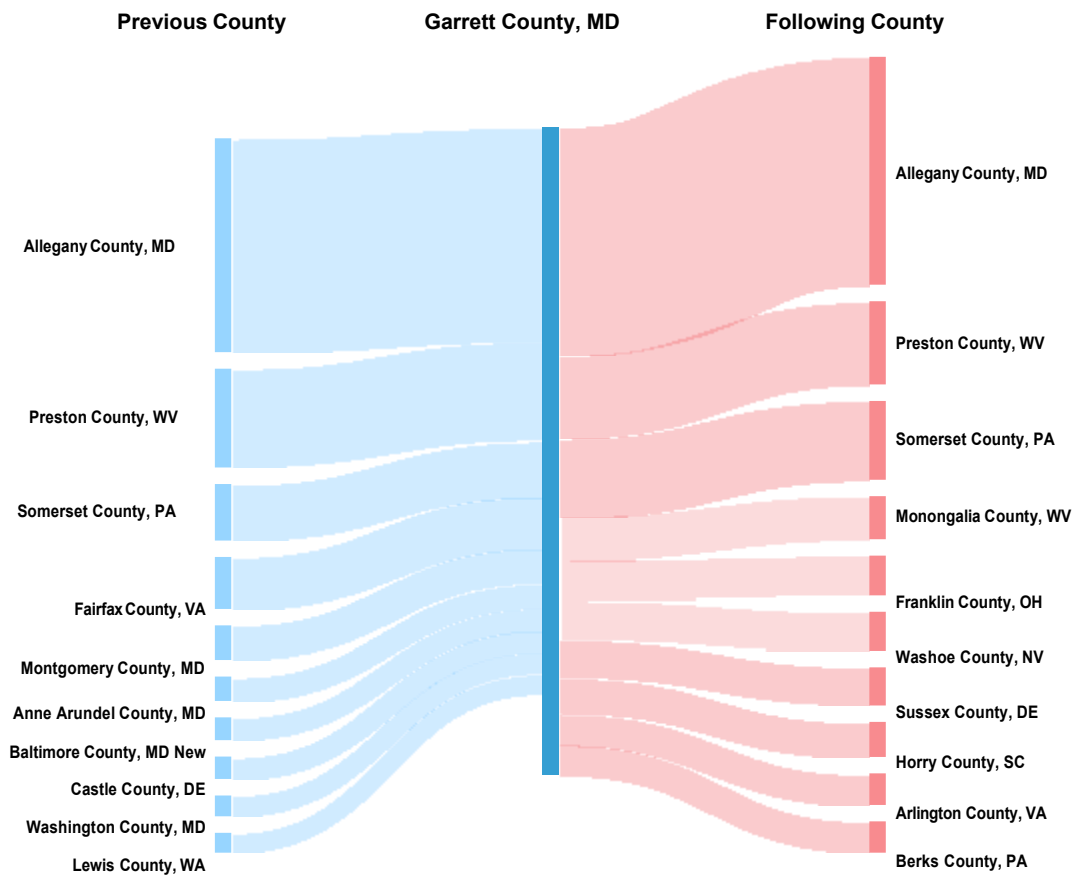
## Reliable Commuting Information Is Not Available

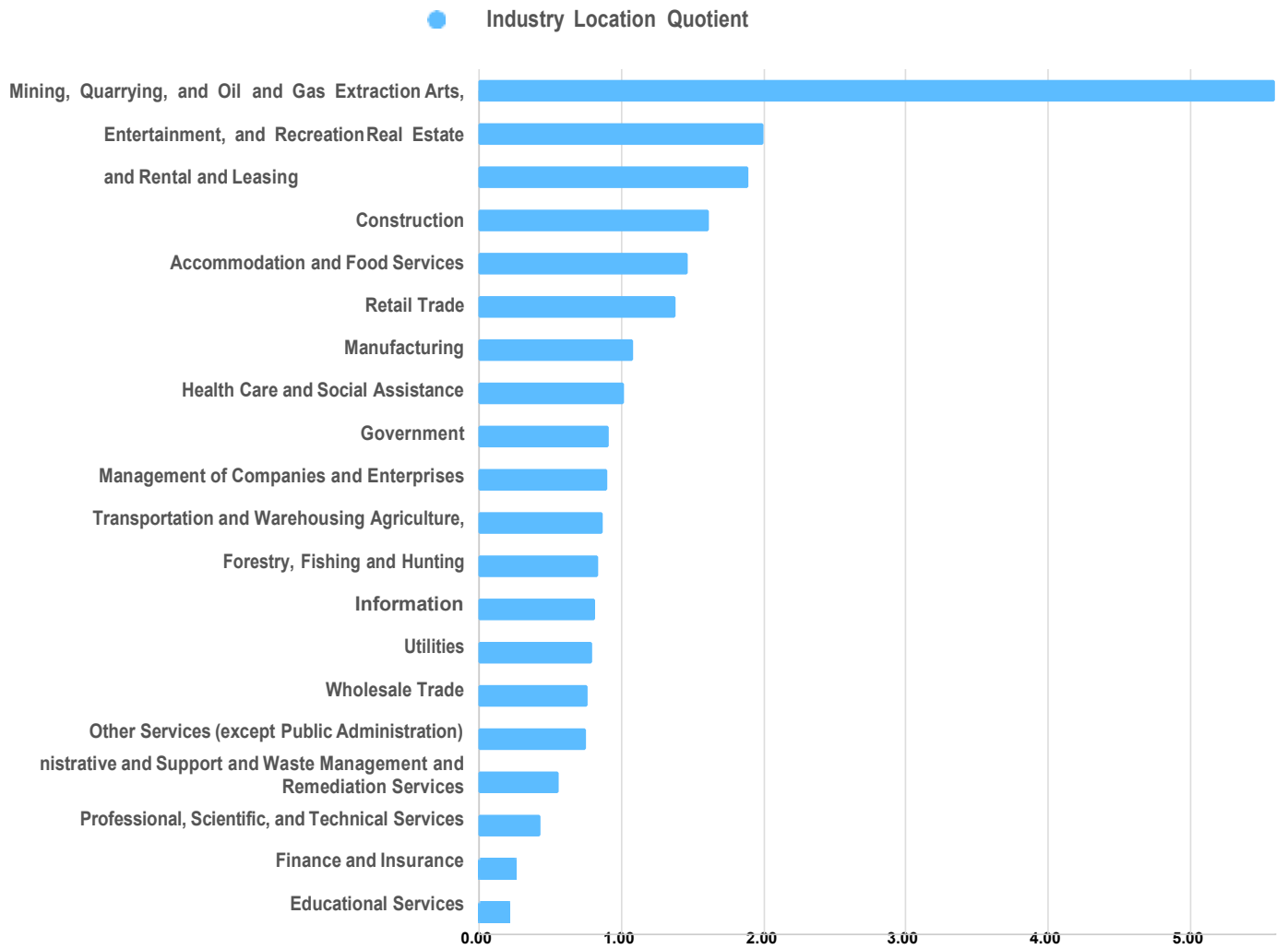

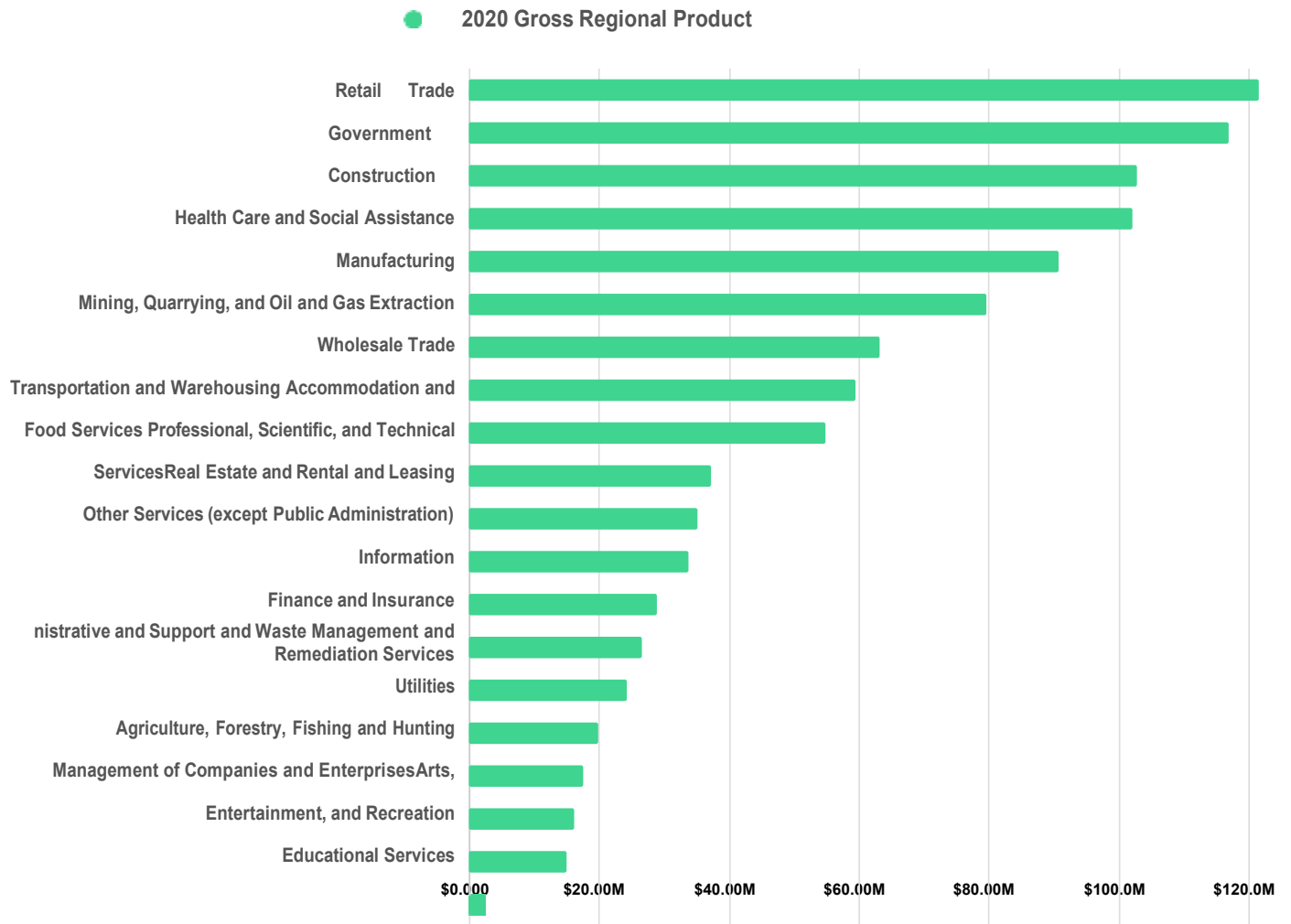

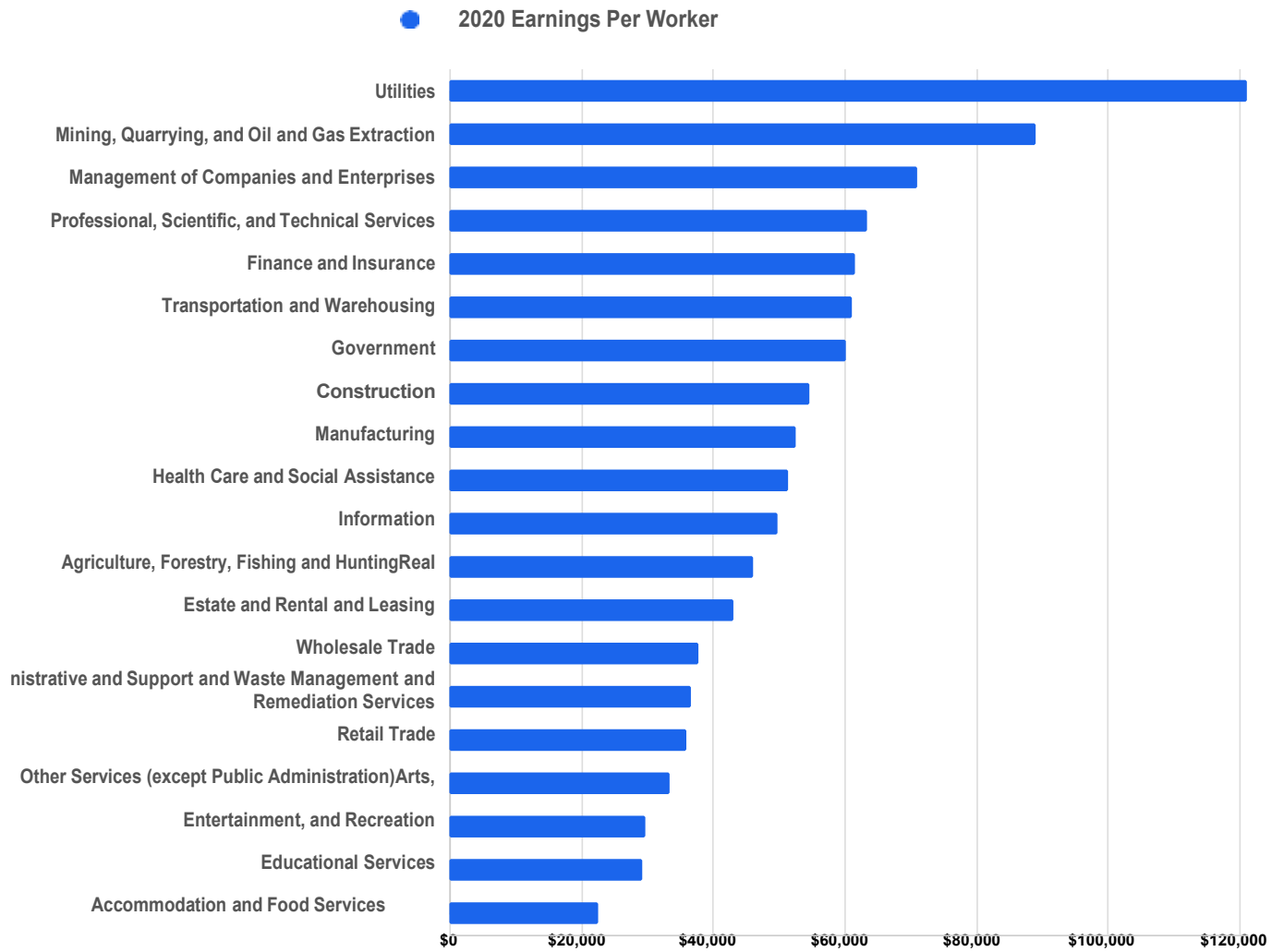




## Top Industry GRP

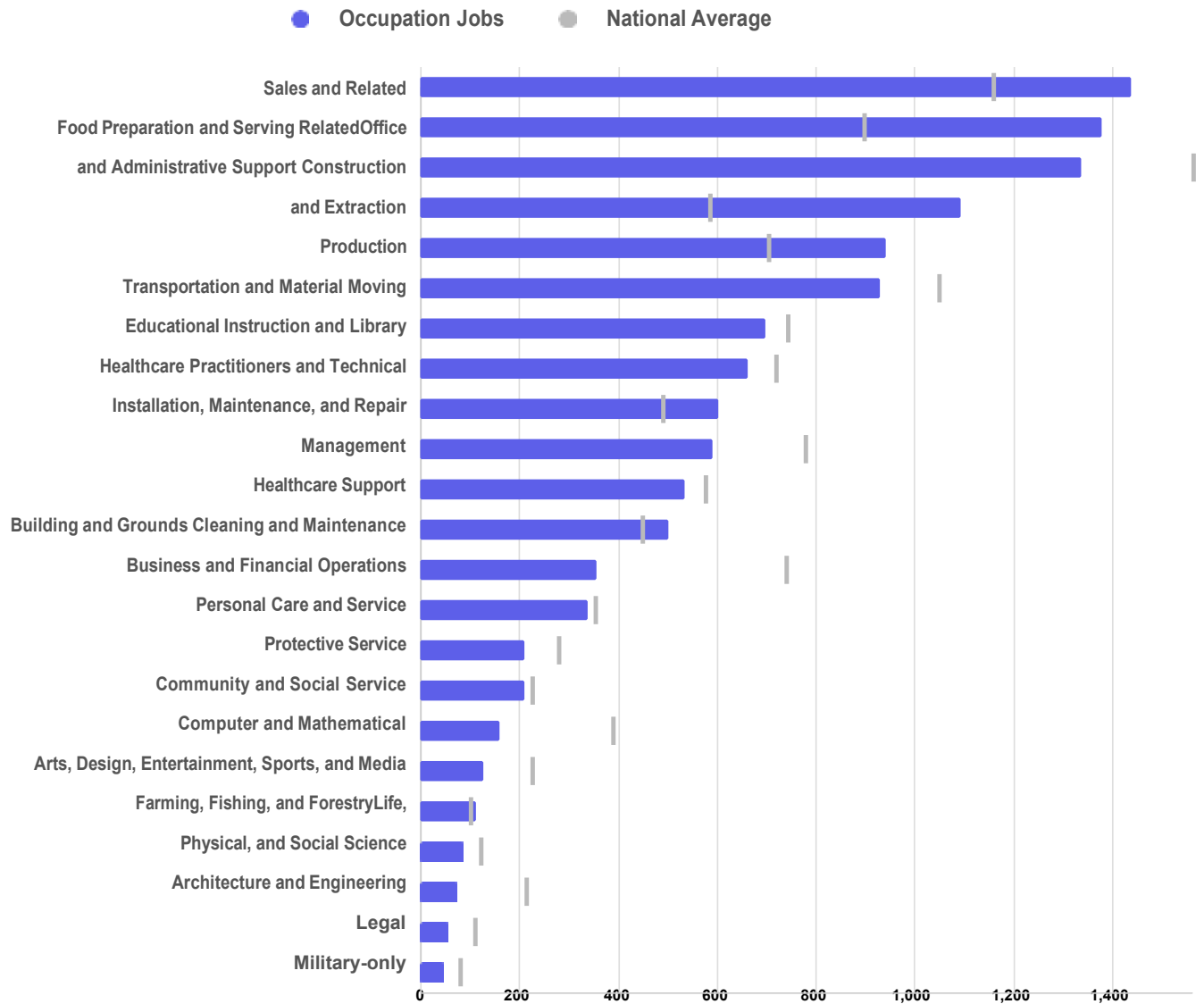

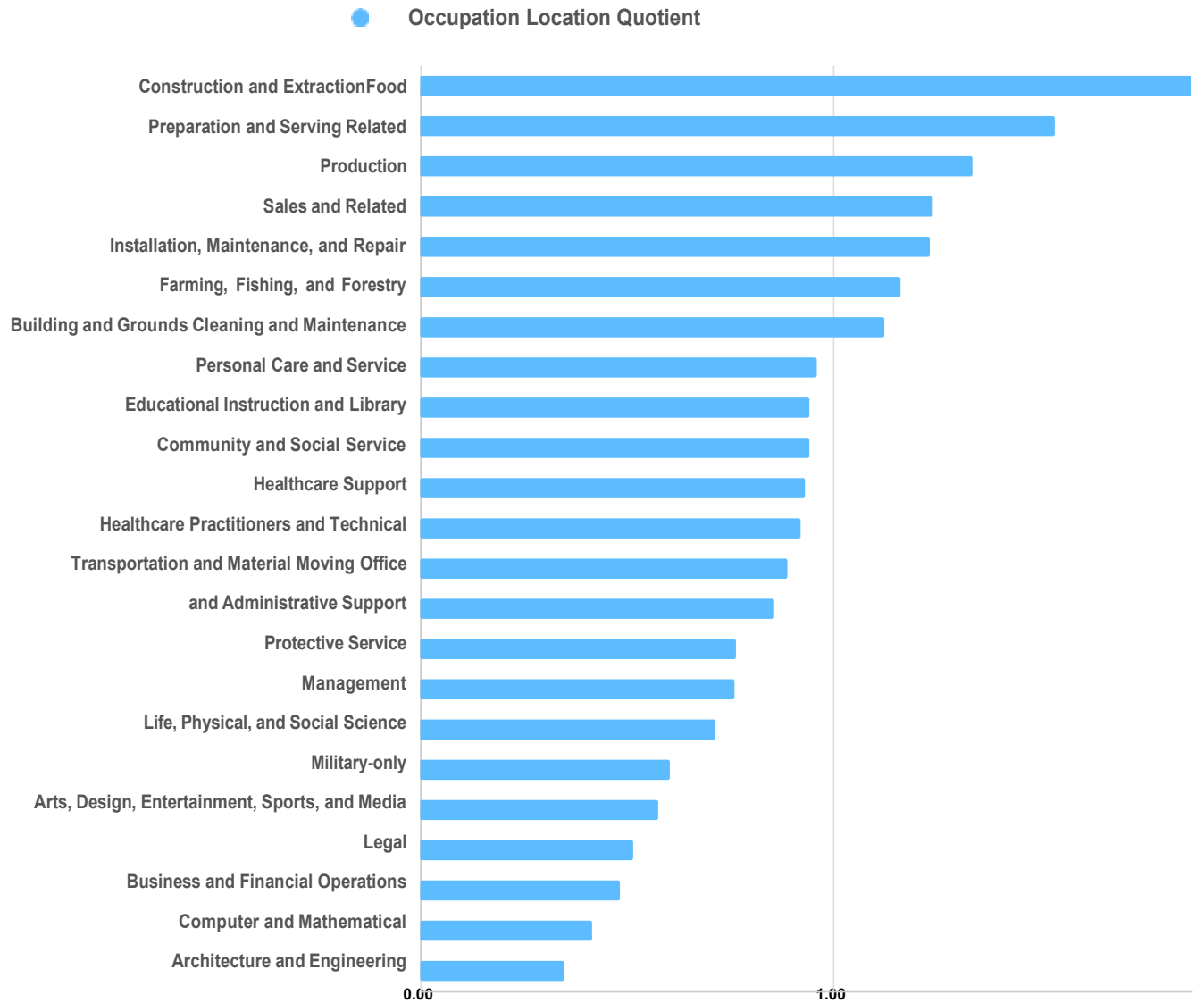

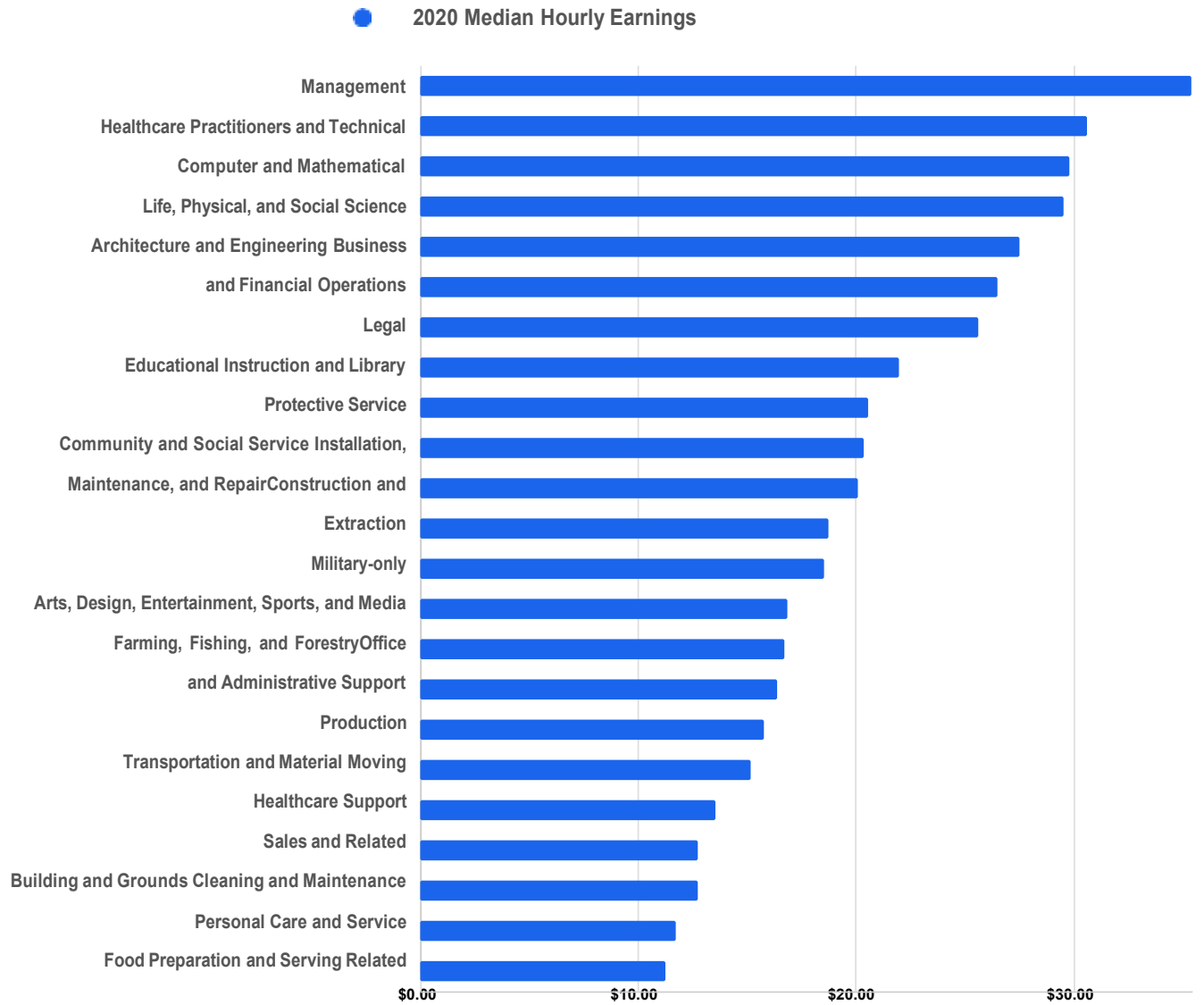

## Top Occupation Location Quotient

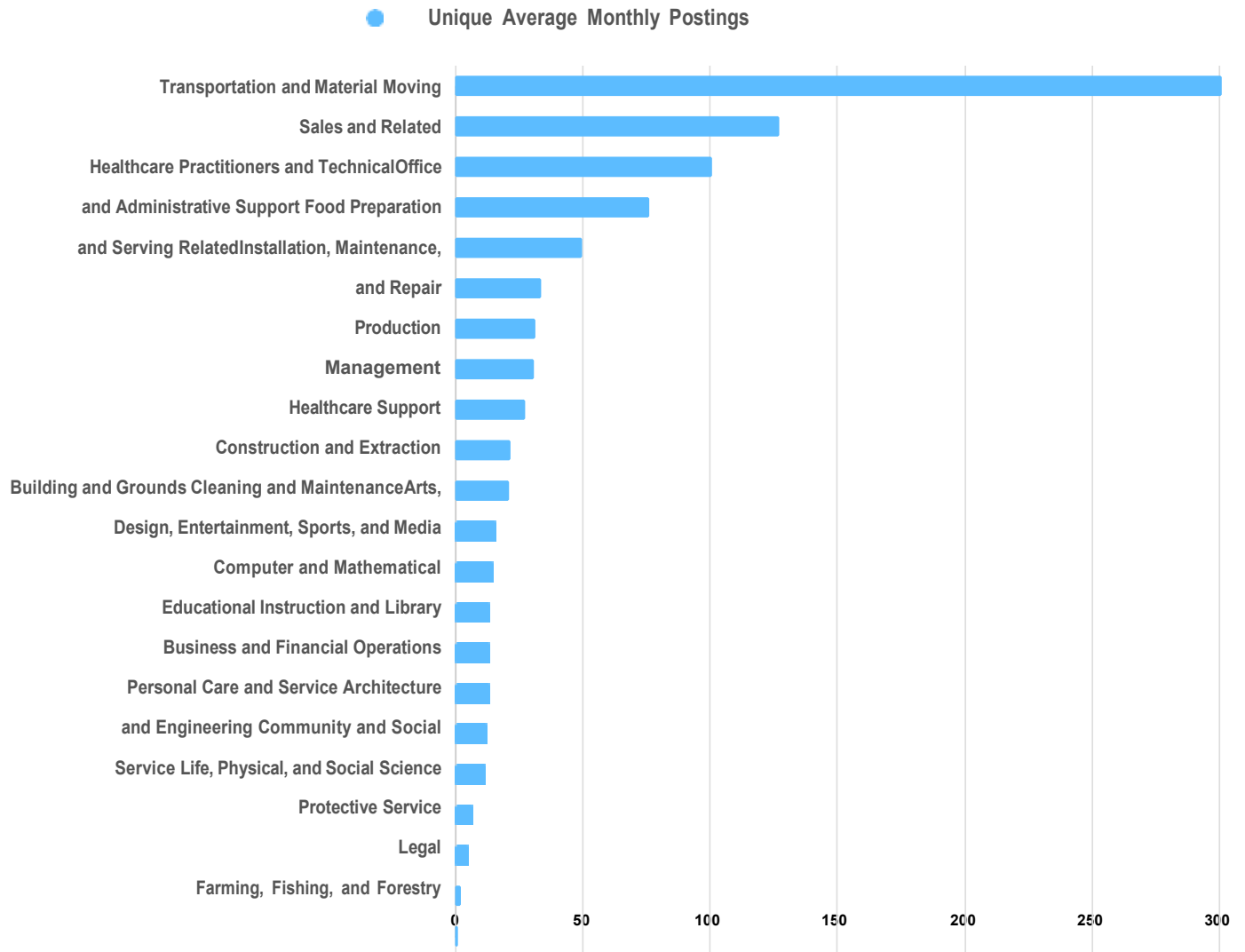

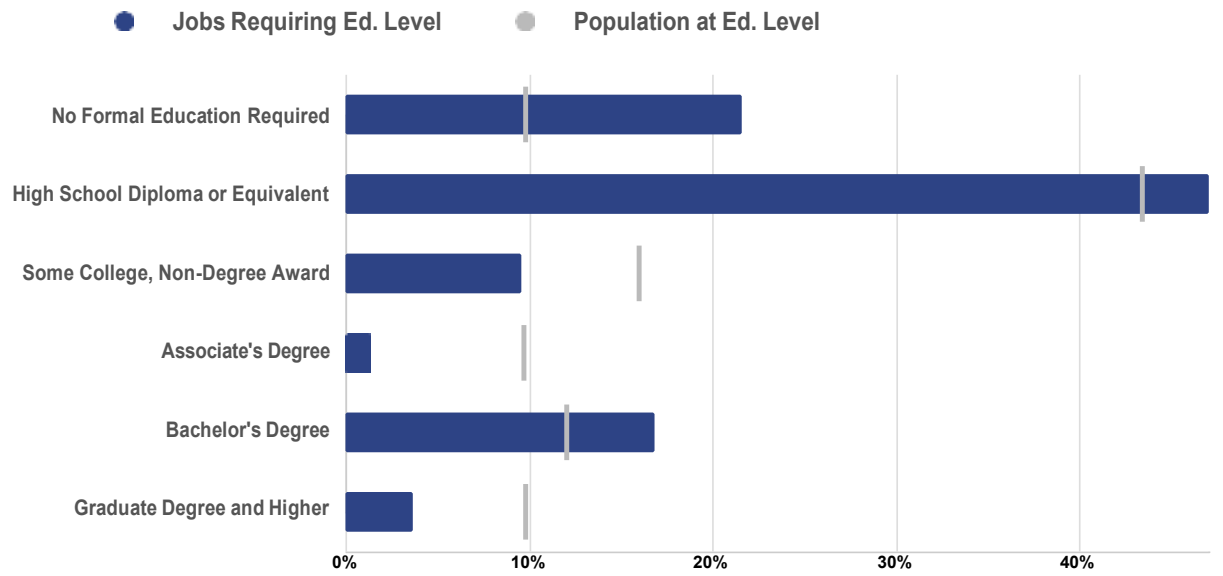

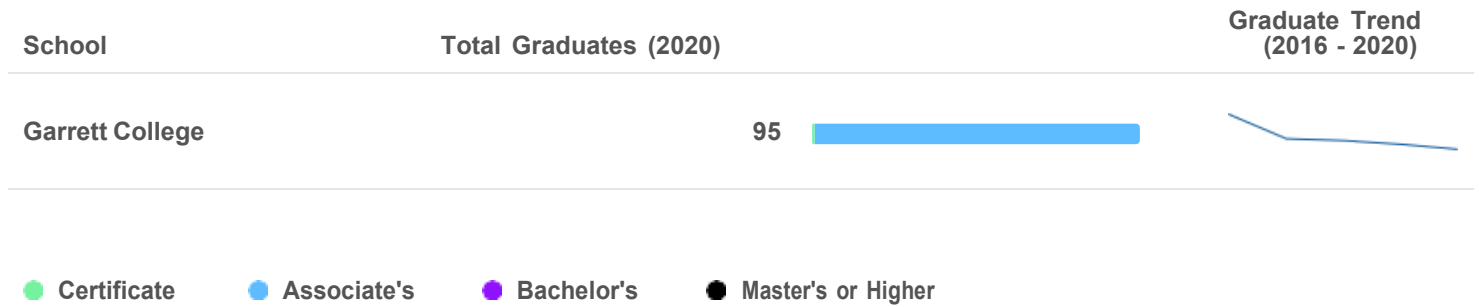
